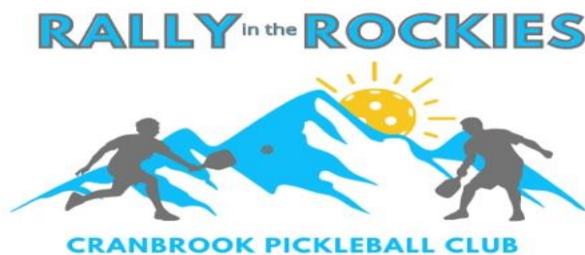

MUSIC

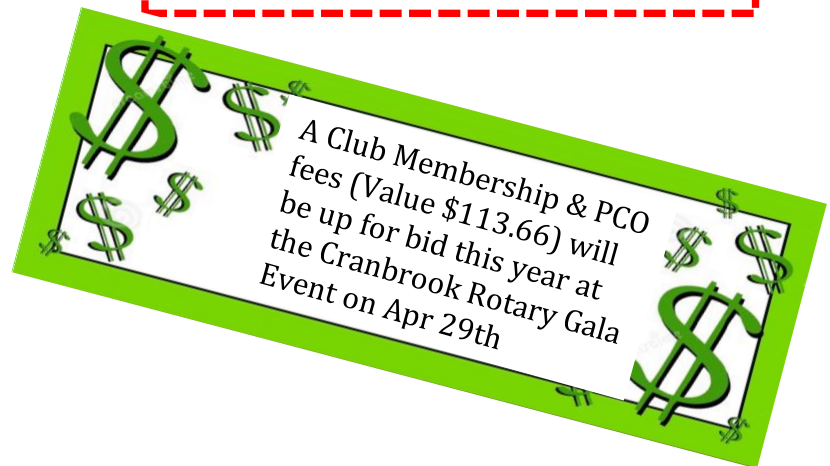
CPC POLICY:
